TEACHERS DO's and DON'T's

DO

- Encourage the children who are old enough to research endangered species
- Make sure that they all use good quality A3 paper (11" x 17" in the US)
- Encourage them to use clear, bold strokes and colours.
- Make sure that the School Form is fully completed.
- Encourage the children to leave a margin between their animal and the edge of the paper (so nothing gets chopped off in scanning)
- Make sure that the pictures are not creased or folded in any way.
- Make sure that every picture has its forms attached and the parental consent form is signed
- Thoroughly protect the pictures when wrapping them up to post.

DON'T

- Let the children use poor quality paper or paper less than A3 in size.
- Let the children create faint drawings – they don't work well.
- Let the children use chalk or pencil – it smudges (pencil is ok for outlines)
- Leave out the School Registration Form from the package.
- Let the pictures get creased or folded
- Send any picture without both forms being securely attached
- Send inadequately protected pictures through the post.
